- □ Letter of recommendation from a music teacher or private instructor
- □ Video audition
- $\hfill\square$  An essay by the applicant explaining why they want to attend MWROC
- □ 2 years of tax returns (just the last page showing income) verifying financial situation. You may also submit a letter stating change of family circumstance; i.e., illness, fire, loss of job.

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### **Rules and Requirements**

### **The ASCAP Foundation Scholarship**

• Available to musicians and singers between the ages of 12-21 who <u>compose their own</u> <u>music/songs, and are awarded based on talent and financial need.</u> ASCAP is particularly looking for talented young singer/songwriters.

### **All Other Scholarship Opportunities**

- Available to musicians and singers between the ages of 12-21, based on talent and financial need. (Please note: The Lisle Violin Shop "Find Your Forte" scholarship is only available to TX residents.)
- <u>All applicants must fill out our **Scholarship Application Form** (attached).</u>
  - If you are awarded any of our scholarships, you will be required to fill out an online registration as well (instructions will be sent to you).
- <u>All applicants must submit **a video audition** performing 1-2 selections that demonstrate musical ability.</u>
  - If submitting for the ASCAP Scholarship, video must include original composition(s).
  - If submitting for all other scholarships, video must include 1 classical/traditional and 1 contemporary piece.
  - Videos may be posted on YouTube (or any other video posting site; i.e., Vimeo), or sent via regular mail on DVD or USB thumb drive. **Please note:** If you post online and you do not want your audition to be publicly viewed, you may choose to keep the link unlisted.
- **One sealed recommendation letter** from a professional musician such as an orchestra or choir director or a private teacher sent by regular mail directly to the MWROC office (see attached **Recommendation Form**). MWROC is looking for students who are serious musicians and are leaders in their school music programs.
- **<u>A one-page essay</u>** written by the applicant about the importance of music in student's life, and what student hopes to gain from their experience at MWROC.
- <u>Application and other materials must be postmarked or emailed by April 30</u>. No submissions will be considered after that date.
- <u>All recipients will be notified by MWROC via email on or before June 15.</u> If you have any questions regarding whether or not a scholarship was granted to an applicant, please contact us after that date.
